## First Holy Communion Photographs

As I informed you earlier in the year, the Photographer has been booked for **Tuesday 14th June** (next Tuesday) to take the First Holy Communion photographs of children in both Mr Bonnar and Mrs Scott's classes.

Children will have their photographs taken both **individually and as a class** in church.

Children should arrive at St. John Vianney church at **8.45am and no later than 8.55am** in their First Holy Communion clothes.

## First Holy Communion Party in School

Once the children have had their photographs taken on Tuesday, they will get changed into their own clothes and they will be walked back to school by members of staff. Children should bring a suitable bag to transport their communion outfit back to school.

The children will then celebrate making their First Holy Communion with a party day in school. We will provide the cake and party food for all of our children. If your child has a food allergy we ask that, due to the change in legislation and the introduction of Natasha's Law, that you please provide a plate of party food yourself to ensure that no child is jeopardised by any cross contamination of party food and allergies.

All children in Year 4 should bring their own clothes to church on Tuesday 14th June as ALL children in Year 4, regardless of whether or not they have made their First Holy Communion, will take part in the Party Day with their class. Party clothes should be brought in a bag and the children will get changed into their party clothes in church.

If your child did not make their First Holy Communion, they should still come to church but in their party clothes at the above time of between 8.45am – 8.55am.
