## **HEALTH RELATED BEHAVIOUR SURVEY - YEAR 4**

Our school, along with several others, has agreed to participate in a very important Health Behaviour Survey of children and young people. This survey supports the work of Newcastle City Council and its partners in the NHS.

We stand to benefit through our participation in the survey in a number of ways. For example; the survey results may prompt us to review the Personal Social Health and Economic Education (PSHCE) curriculum. It will also help as a;

- Starting point for classroom discussion and activities
- Guide in choosing resource materials to support healthier lifestyle choices
