Fair Trade

As a school we have wanted to launch a Fairtrade provision for pupils, however we have become more and more aware that in can be very expensive and we are sensitive to families in the current cost of living challenges. So, we have changed from selling Fair Trade products to pupils weekly, to giving every child a Fair-Trade packet of Maltesers, which are made using the Fair-Trade values. We are teaching pupils about the

important work and mission of the Fair-Trade movement which is committed to promoting an ethical living wage for all involved.

End of Term Whole School Mass

On Tuesday 20th December all the pupils will come together and celebrate mass with Father Martin leading us together in our spiritual preparation for Christmas.

<u>Attendance / Punctuality</u>

Please can I remind parent's that attendance and punctuality is very important to your child's education. Where attendance and or punctuality has been identified as an issue Grant Short, our school attendance officer, will contact families and speak to them about ways to best support you to bring your child in every day and on time. If your child is collected before the end of the school day, you will be asked to provide evidence of their appointment and reason for leaving early. If they come into school late it will be recorded on the register, it also disrupts their start to the day and can distress children.

Holidays during term time

Just to remind parents that if you take your child out of school for a holiday the attendance officer, Grant Short, will contact you. The Local Authority is also likely to make contact to ensure that parents understand children should be in school all year round.
