Support the mental health and well-being of our pupils

We have a number of things we are doing in school to support the mental health and well-being of all of our pupils.

- The SEMH groups are now all back up and running and I know that they have been really well received by the children
- The counsellor continues to come in once a week from the road centre
- Rainbows bereavement and therapy sessions are now available for any pupil who needs it
- There are Lego and various therapy groups up and running
- Teachers are running wellbeing drop in sessions for their classes
- Daily emotional check in boards for all children
- Talking groups in the early years
- 20/20/20 lunchtime sessions for the older children
- Mental health and well-being afternoons are being run by class teachers
- Mindful sessions of quiet reflective time are being built into the curriculum through creative prayer and reflection time
- Time out and support sessions for pupils who would benefit from movement breaks and time out of class to stop them becoming overwhelmed
- A plethora of individual bespoke activities have been set up for a number of our children on a 1-2-1 basis
