The new family partner, Emma Brumwell, was in school and again, we have uploaded some new materials advertising a number of courses and support groups for pupils and parents to access, in the area.

Attendance / Punctuality

Please can I remind parent's that attendance and punctuality is very important to your child's education. Where attendance and or punctuality has been identified as an issue Grant Short, our school attendance officer, will contact families and speak to them about ways to best support you to bring your child in every day and on time. If your child is collected before the end of the school day, you will be asked to provide evidence of their appointment and reason for leaving early. If they come into school late it will be recorded on the register, it also disrupts their start to the day and can distress children.

School Dinners

Please can we remind parent's that if your child wants to switch between packed lunch and school dinner, <u>we need 2 weeks' notice</u> of this change, either way. It is not possible to accommodate daily changes, as the kitchen is unable to access daily deliveries and need time to plan and order food for everyone.

On Tuesday 1^{st} November, pupils took time out of their day, in an age appropriate way, to remember those who have died. They were thoughtful and considerate of everyone around them and we were really proud of them.

Whole school Geography day

On Monday 7th November the children will be taking part a Geography Day in school. We are asking the children to come in dressed in the colours of the country's flag their class will be learning about that day. This day is linked to COP 27, which is being held in Sharm El-Sheikh, Egypt. The conference is being held between the 7th - 18th November 2022, where many countries will gather and discuss the promises from COP26 and how they can be implemented. This day is also celebrating Geography Awareness Week, which begins the week commencing Monday 14th November. Geography Awareness Week aims to raise the significance of geography in everyone's lives and encourages our students to think about their relationship with the environment.

On Monday, the children will learn about what happens at the conference of parties (COP27) and what their chosen country is currently doing to combat climate change. During the afternoon, we will gather together, and each class will present some information they have learnt about that day.

Reception - South Africa (red, white, green, yellow, black and blue)

Year 1 - Finland (white and blue)

Year 2 - France (blue, white and red)

Year 3 - Germany (black, red and yellow)

Year 4 - Greece (blue and white)

Year 5 - Switzerland (red and white)

Year 6 - Côte d'Ivoire (orange, white and green)

We are sure the children will enjoy exploring the different countries and how they can protect 'Our Common Home' (Laudato Si' – Pope Francis). We hope they will have a fun day and enjoy sharing
