Newcastle City Council has informed schools that from the <u>Monday 7th April 2025</u>, they are increasing the school catering charge to £3 per meal. St John Vianney Catholic Primary School and BBCET recognises this is a significant increase for parents from the current price. We all know the know the importance of a pupil receiving a hot, nutritious school meal. Consequently, we are doing what we can to limit the impact of this cost and have agreed to limit the price passed to parents to £2.70 until 1st April 2026.
