On Monday 7th November the children will be taking part a Geography Day in school. We are asking the children to come in dressed in the colours of the country's flag their class will be learning about that day. This day is linked to COP 27, which is being held in Sharm El-Sheikh, Egypt. The conference is being held between the 7th - 18th November 2022, where many countries will gather and discuss the promises from COP26 and how they can be implemented. This day is also celebrating Geography Awareness Week, which begins the week commencing Monday 14th November. Geography Awareness Week aims to raise the significance of geography in everyone's lives and encourages our students to think about their relationship with the environment.

On Monday 7th November, the children will learn about what happens at the conference of parties (COP27) and what their chosen country is currently doing to combat climate change. During the afternoon, we will gather together, and each class will present some information they have learnt about that day.

The countries which have been chosen for the classes are:

- Year 3 Germany (black, red and yellow)
- Year 4 Greece (blue and white)
- Year 5 Switzerland (red and white)



Year 6 - Côte d'Ivoire (orange, white and green)

We are sure the children will enjoy exploring the different countries and how they can protect 'Our Common Home' (Laudato Si' – Pope Fancis). We hope they will have a fun day and enjoy sharing what they have learnt with each other and with their families at home.
