The First Holy Communion celebrations are taking place over the next two weekends at St John Vianney Church.

Mr Bonnar's Year 4 on Saturday 10th May 2025 at 10am Mr Peacock's Year4 on Saturday 17th May 2025 at 10am

Over the last 9 months the children have been preparing on a regular basis with the teachers and the parish priests for this important sacrament. A reminder about the arrangements for each service:

- Arrival time at St John Vianney church 9:30am
- The sashes and medals will be sent home from school on Friday 9th and Friday 16th before their class Saturday mass
- Clothes
 - o Girls white dress, optional gloves, optional head dress and wear their medal
 - o Boys Grey trousers or shorts, white shirt and a red first holy communion tie and black shoes. Boys also need to wear their red sash and medal.
- Guests 6 per pew sat with the communicant
- Guests in addition to the above six all others are welcome to attend mass and sit with the parish
- Readings and preparations have all been run through with the children
- Children will have had several practices prior to their sacrament

All children will be given a certificate, a white beaded rosary set and a quilled cross on their photograph day (22nd May 2025) as a memory of their sacrament. School has purchased the rosary beads from Fr David, to support his work in Muhoroni, Kenya. All children need to go straight to church at 8:30am on the 22nd May, dressed in their communion clothes, ready to



have their photographs taken. They need to then bring a bag of party clothes to change to enjoy the rest of the day's celebrations including cake!

Father will offer advice about service protocol prior to each mass.
