Dear Parents and Carers,

COVID Update

In light of the new national governmental concern around the new Omicron COVID variant, we have reassessed our COVID risk assessment. Following government guidance staff continue to not wear masks in front of the children when teaching and learning. Nevertheless, for the last week of term, when parents or grandparents are collecting their children and talking to staff, they will wear a mask and we ask that you also wear a mask.

I appreciate that no one likes wearing them but we have a large number of potentially very vulnerable adults collecting children and we all want to have a safe and happy Christmas free from COVID. So, whilst I cannot enforce this request, I simply ask that you are all as supportive as possible, no one really wants to be ill over Christmas. Staff will also wear mask for the next 9 days when speaking to parents collecting from school. I am hopeful that this is a time limited precaution, that can be swiftly removed in the new year. We will re-evaluate the risk assessment in January, once we return to school in 2022.

COVID Booster Jab – car park busy

We have been made aware that the community center at West Denton will be being used as a COVID booster jab center on Thursday 9th Dec and 16th Dec, therefore the car park will be full. As always, you can use the car park at St John Vianney Church and walk across to school to drop your child and collect your child.
