Dear Parents/Carers,

As you are aware, children in Year 4 undertake the Sacrament of both First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion. Having spoken to Father Paul, we now have confirmed the relevant dates in his diary. We are now able to confirm what the children need to take part in to prepare for these most important Sacraments.

For many years, school has taken the lead when it comes to preparing the pupils in their sacramental preparation. This involves staff delivering a seven-session programme. Mr Bonnar has led this programme for several years and both he and Mr Peacock are going to do so again this year. Father Paul insists that your child must attend all seven sessions, the dates of which are outlined below. On these dates, your child will be asked to stay at school until 4:35pm. They will have a short 10-minute break and snack (For you to provide) on the playground and then attend their session. The children will collect their belongings from their classroom and be dismissed via the green gates at 4.35pm.

In addition to the above seven school-based sessions and the seven Sunday masses, there are also the following two church-based sessions.

The dates for First Reconciliation are as follows: Friday 30th January 2026 at 2pm for children in Mr Bonnar's class. Friday 6th February 2026 at 2pm for children in Mr Peacock's class.

The dates for First Holy Communion itself are as follows: Saturday 9th May 2025 at 10am for children in Mr Bonnar's class. Saturday 16th May 2025 at 10am for children in Mr Peacock's class.

It should be noted that prior to your child being accepted onto this sacramental programme, school must have received a copy of their Catholic baptismal certificate and Father Paul must have confirmed your home address as being within the parish community. Please could you provide him with appropriate evidence to prove your home address, by Friday 24th October. He has also stipulated that he expects every family to attend Holy Mass on the weekend of each school-base session. For example, following the session on Thursday 6th November, you should attend Mass on Sunday 9th November.
